

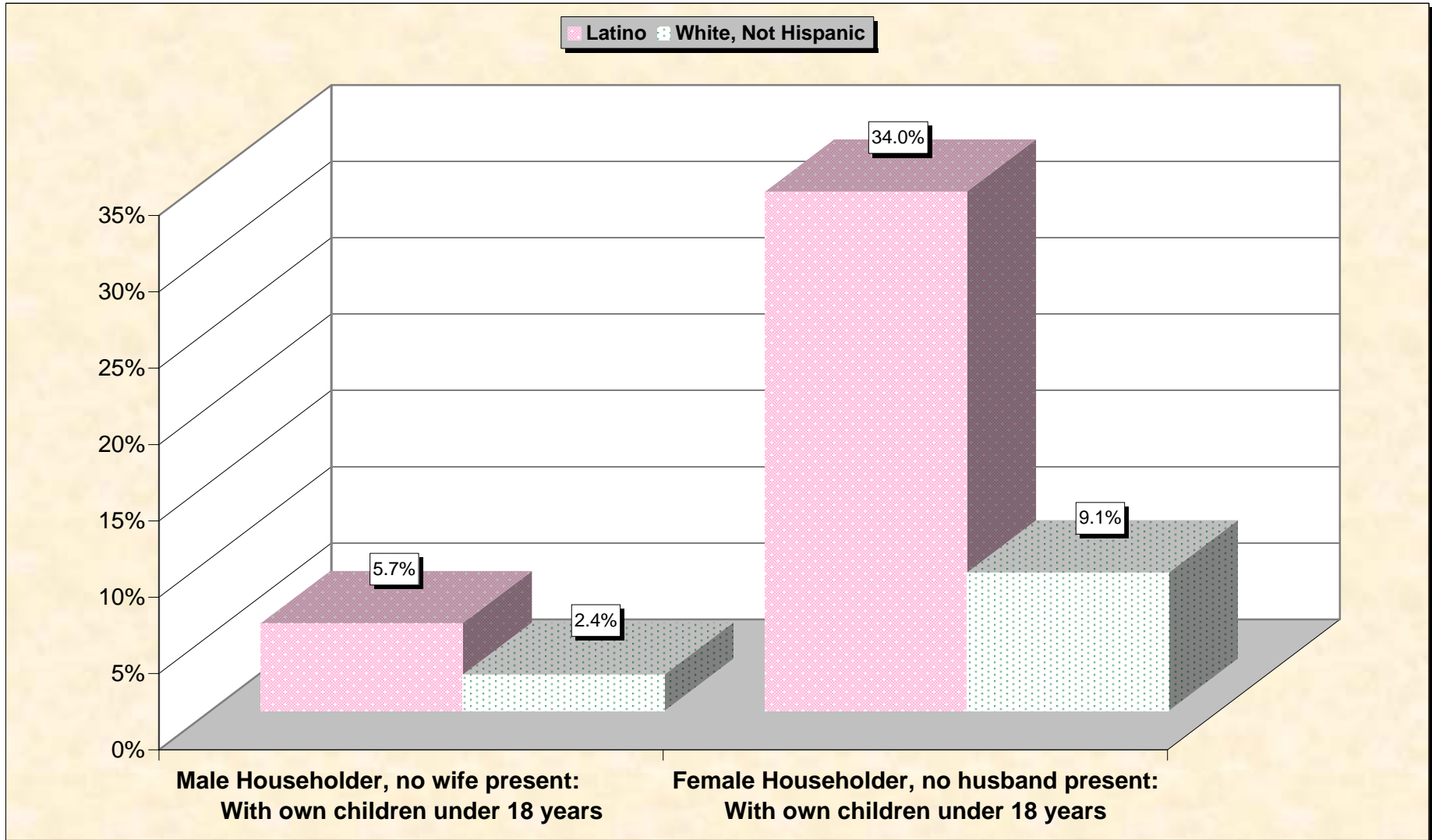

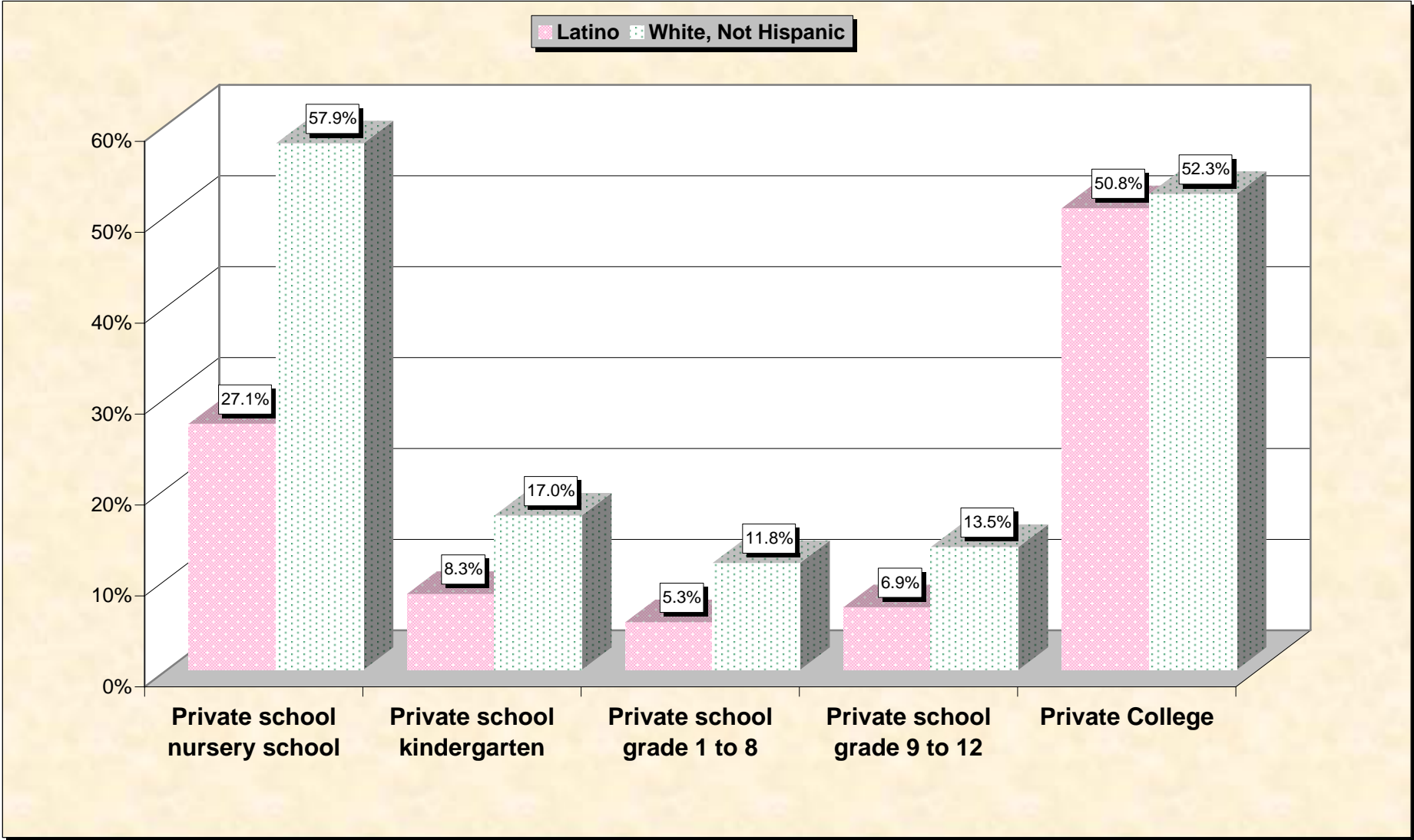

Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Massachusetts



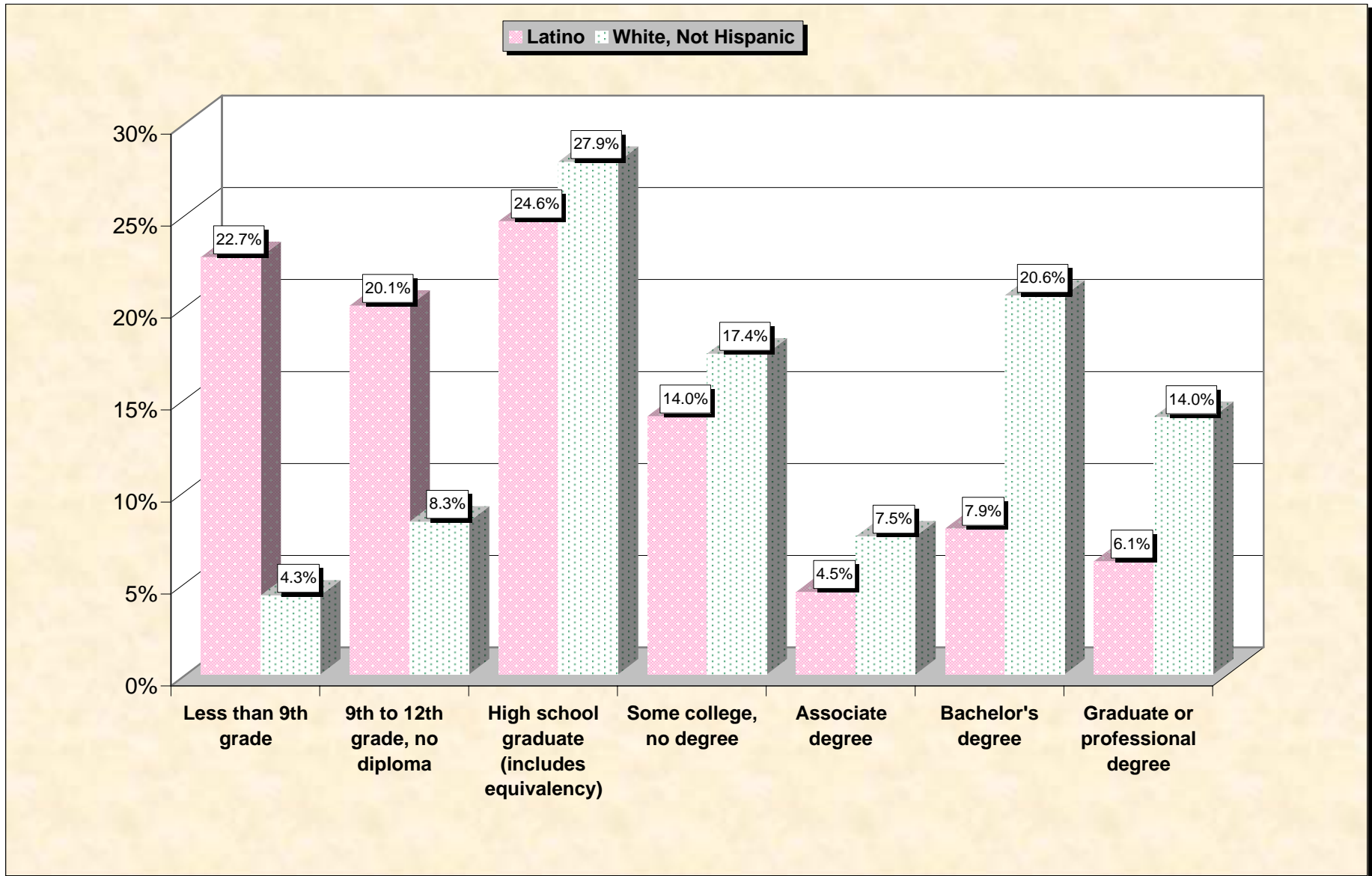

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Massachusetts



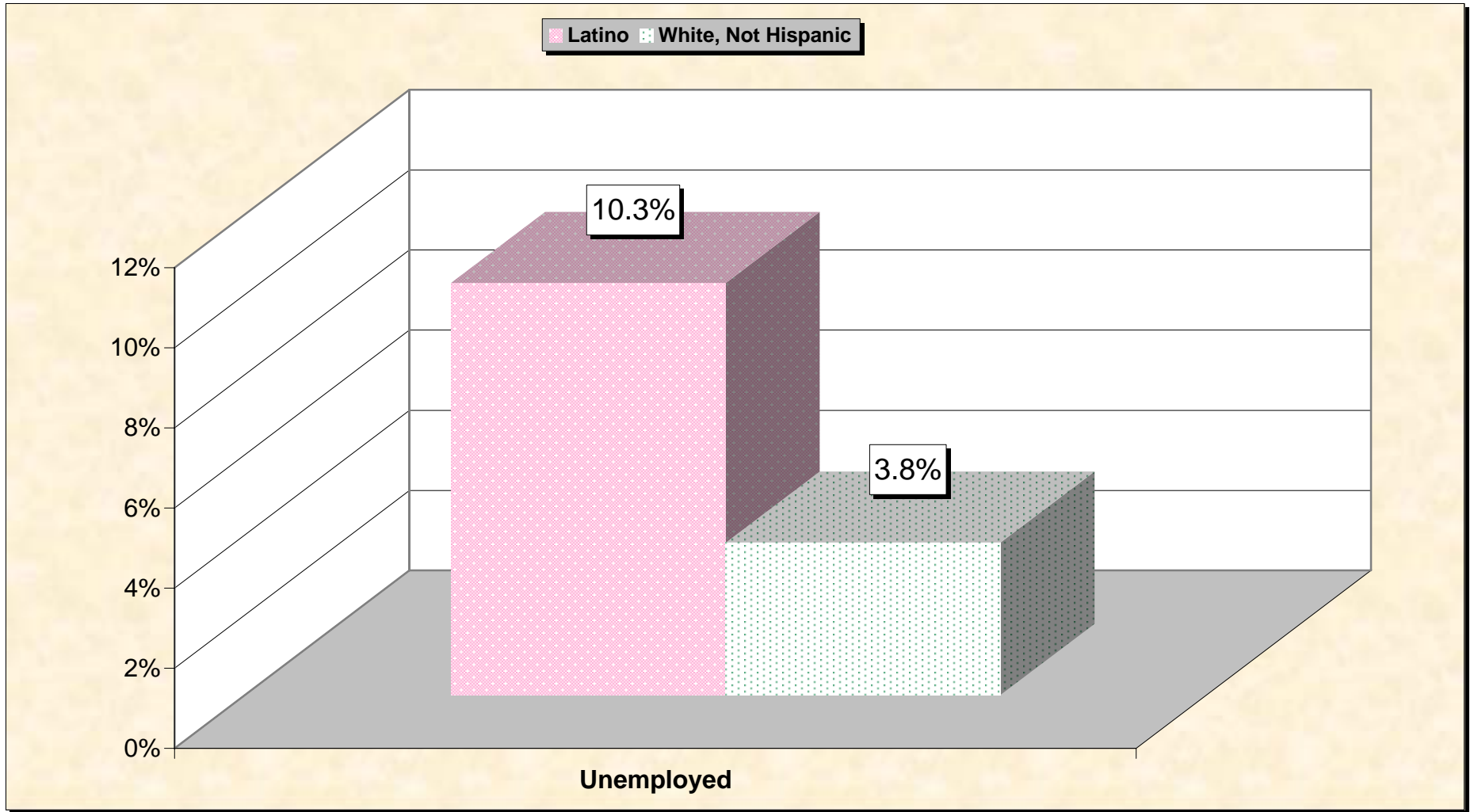

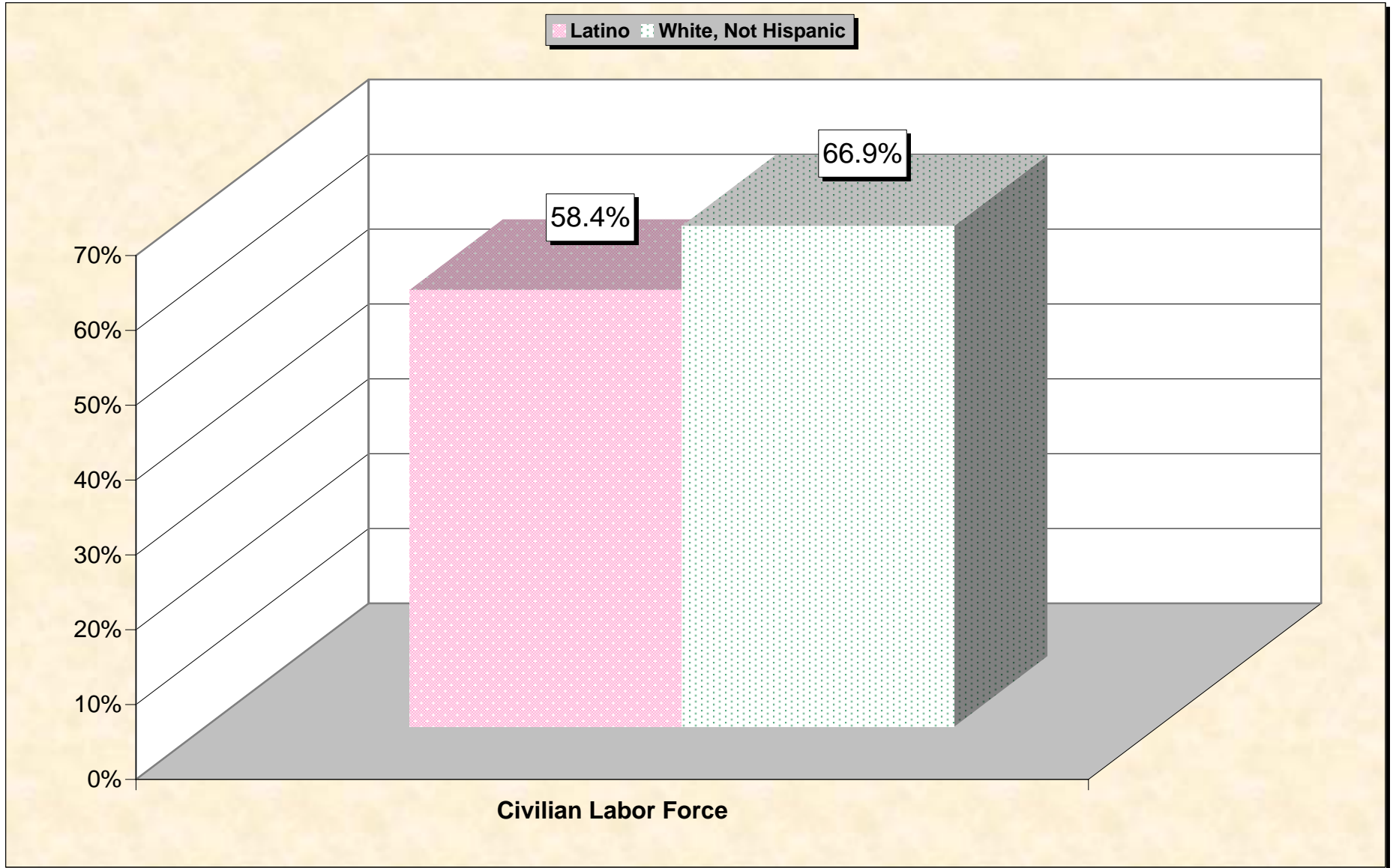
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Massachusetts

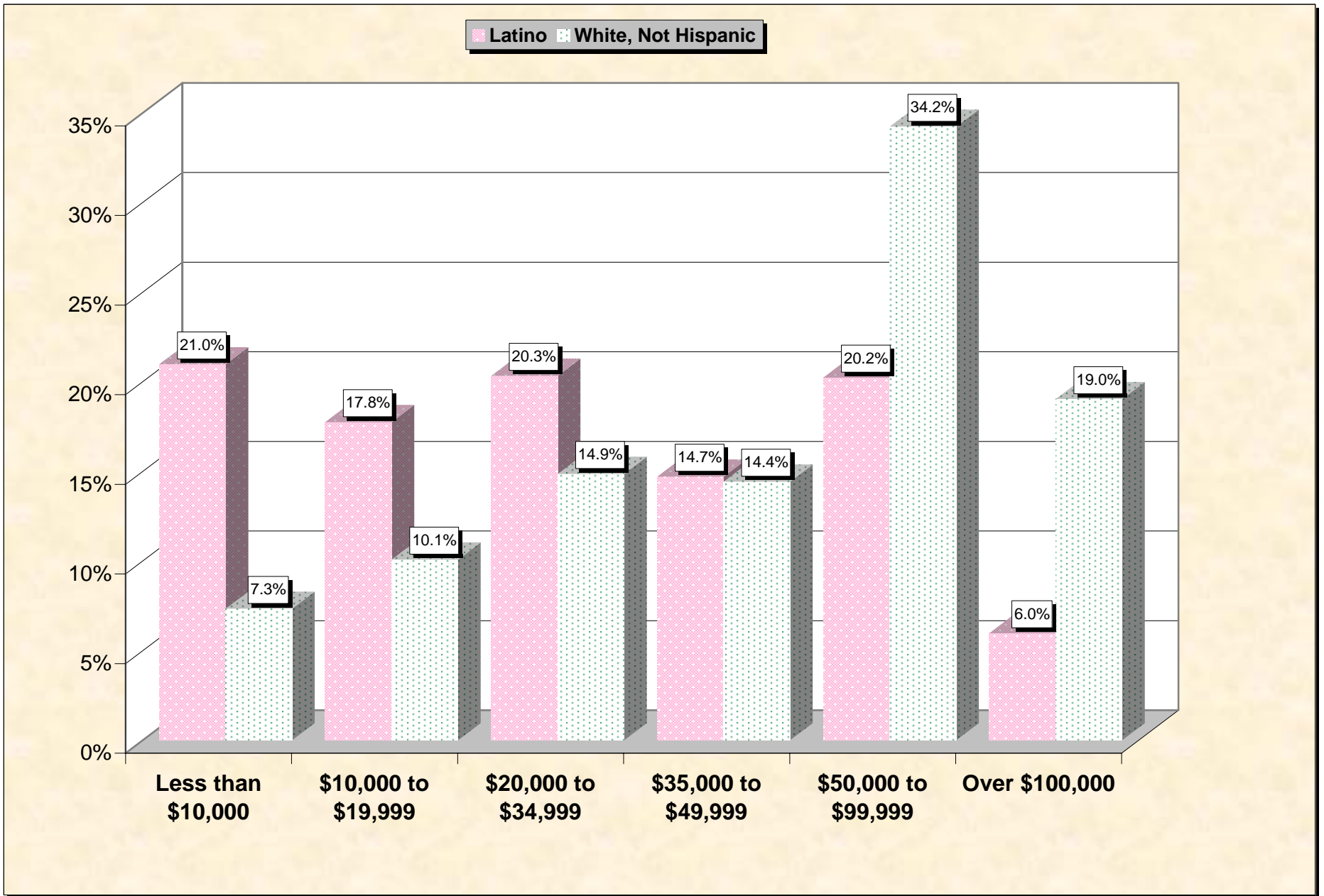
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Massachusetts

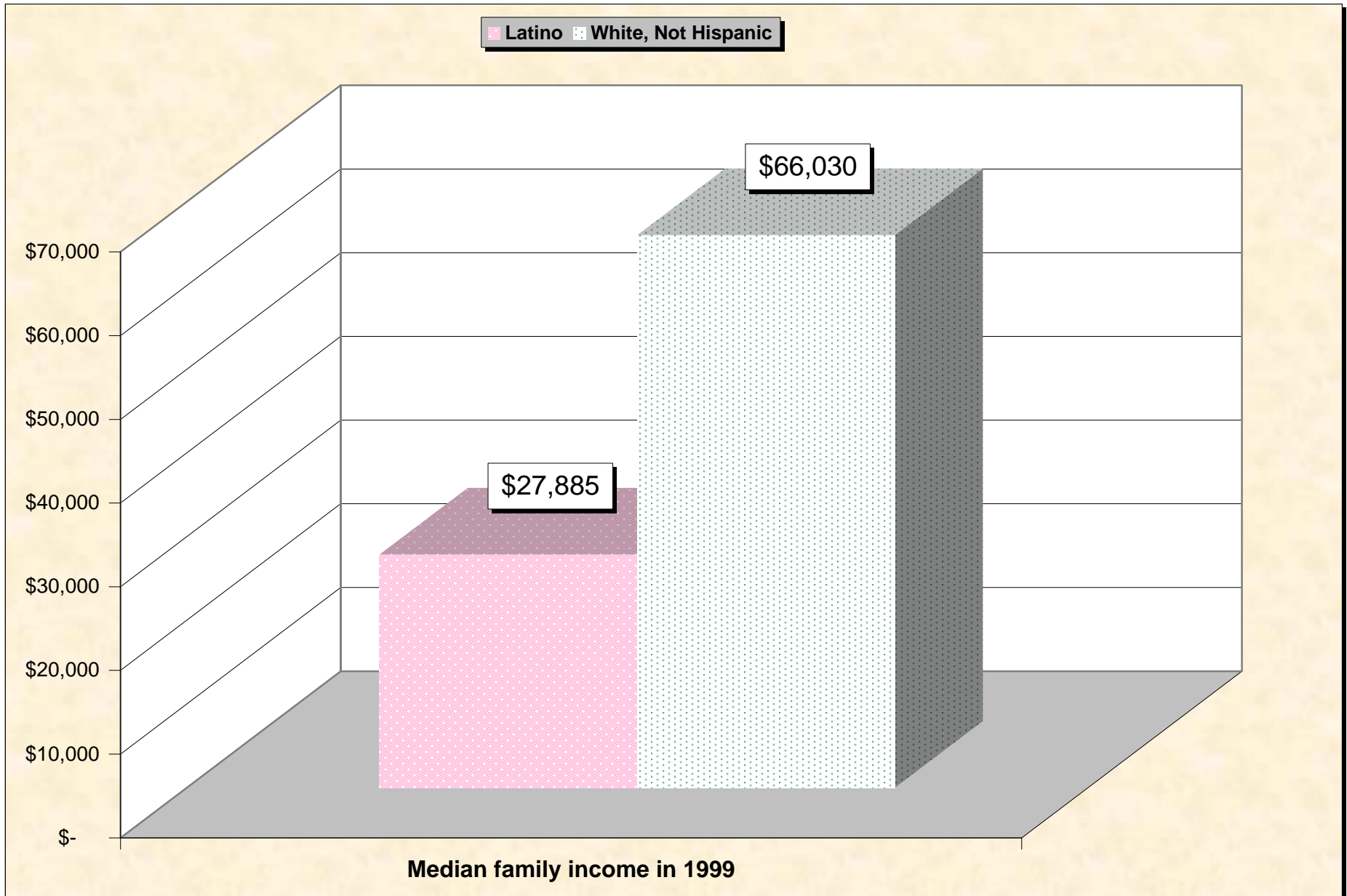

Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Massachusetts



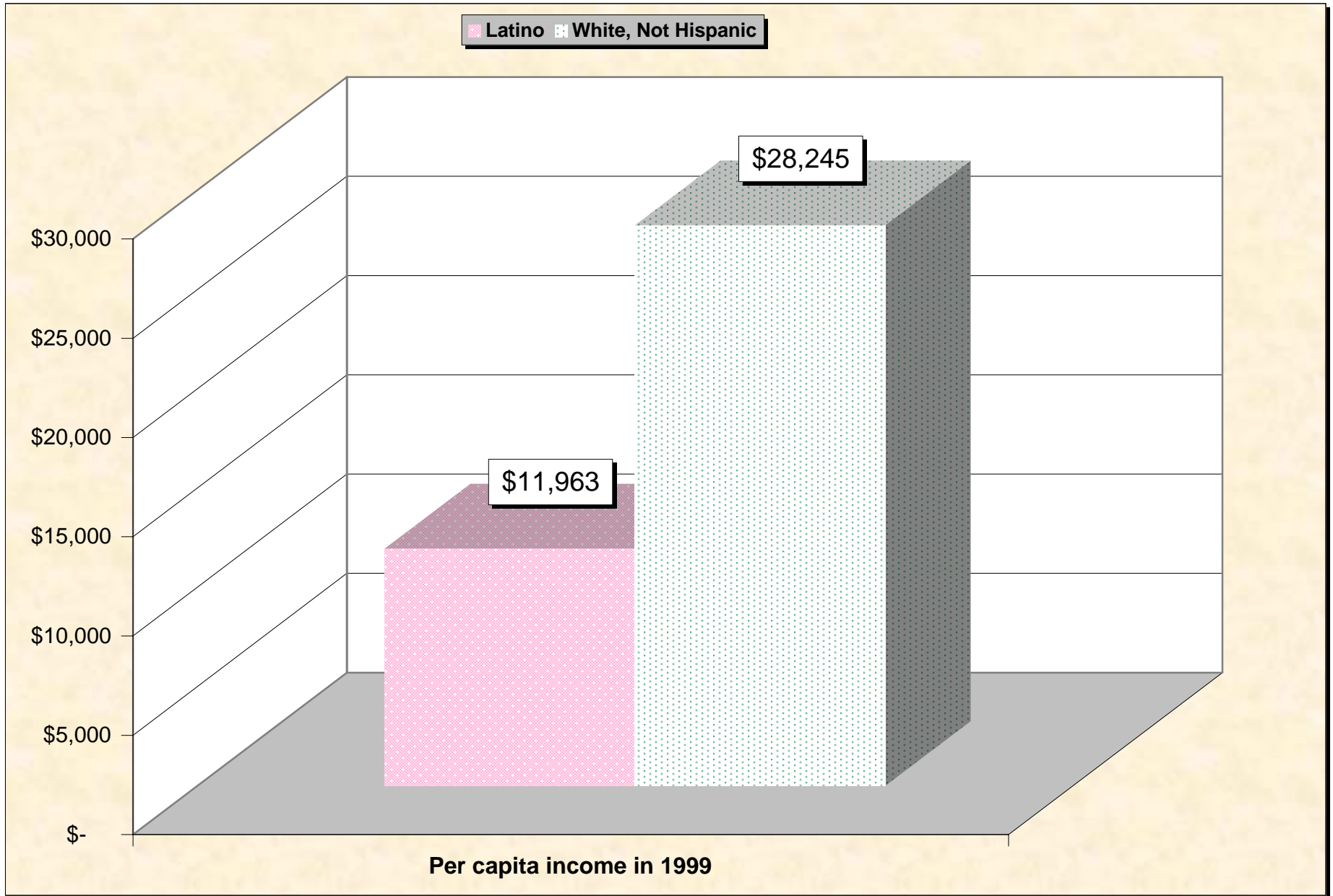

Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Massachusetts



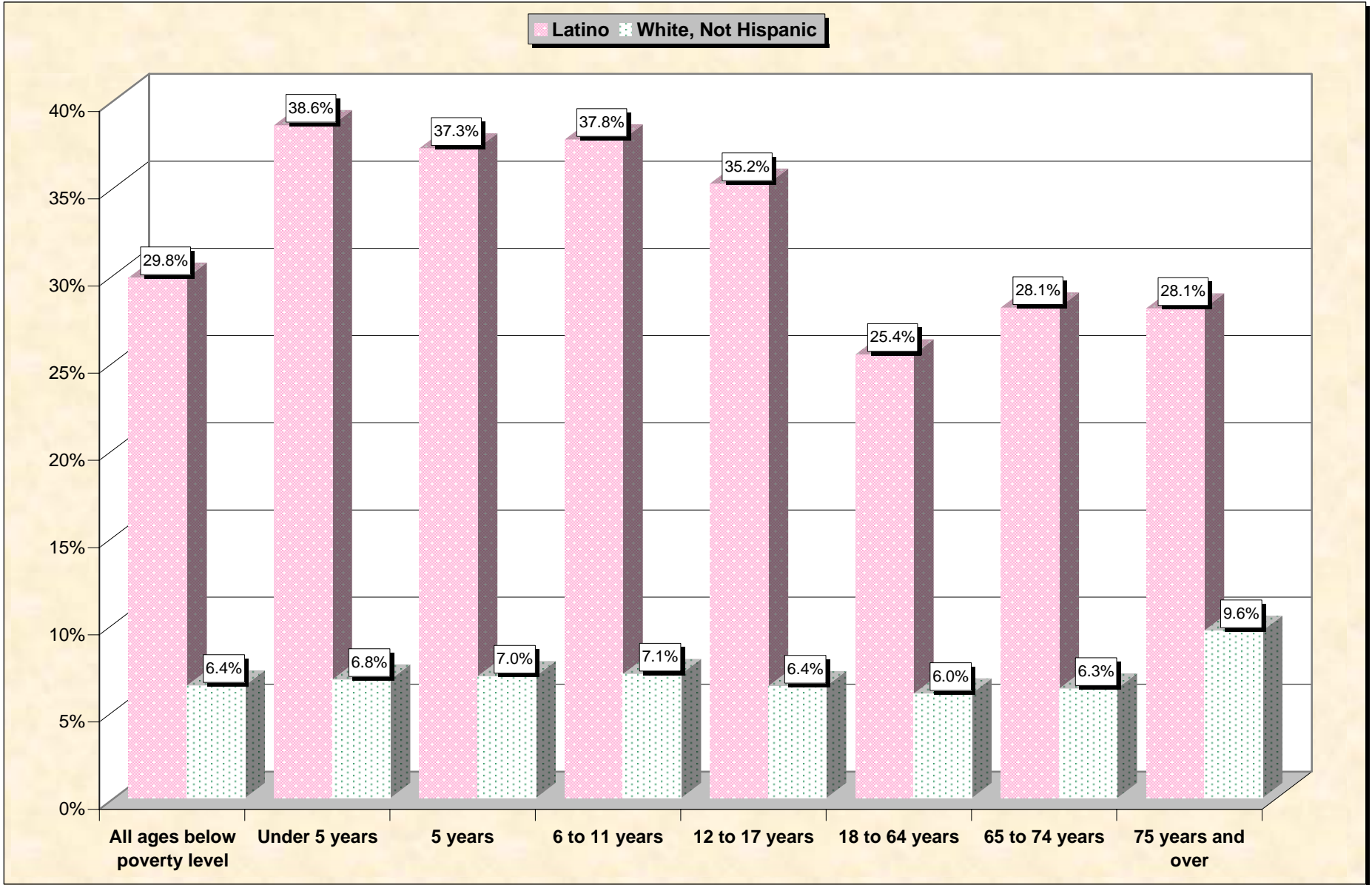

Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Massachusetts



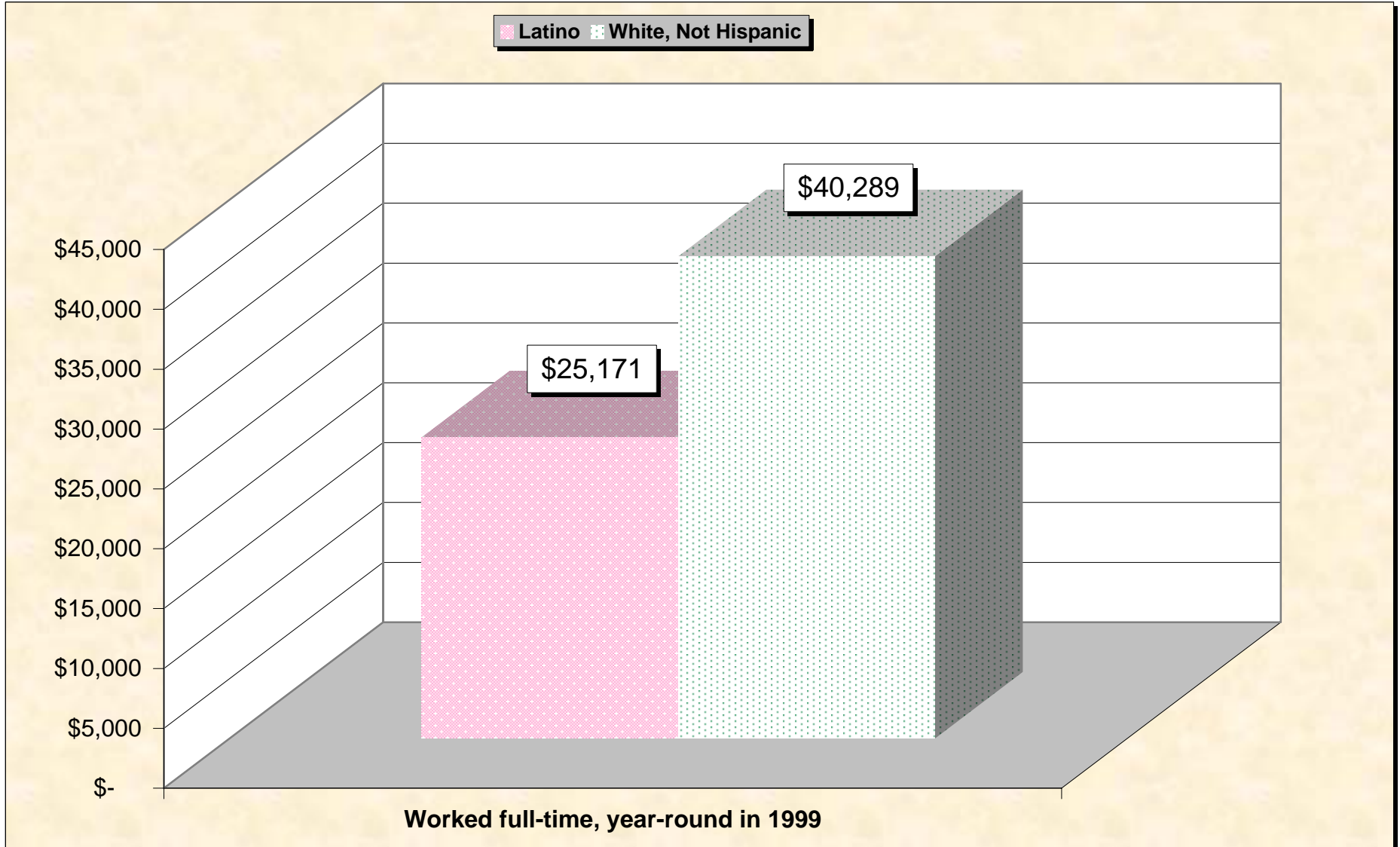

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Massachusetts



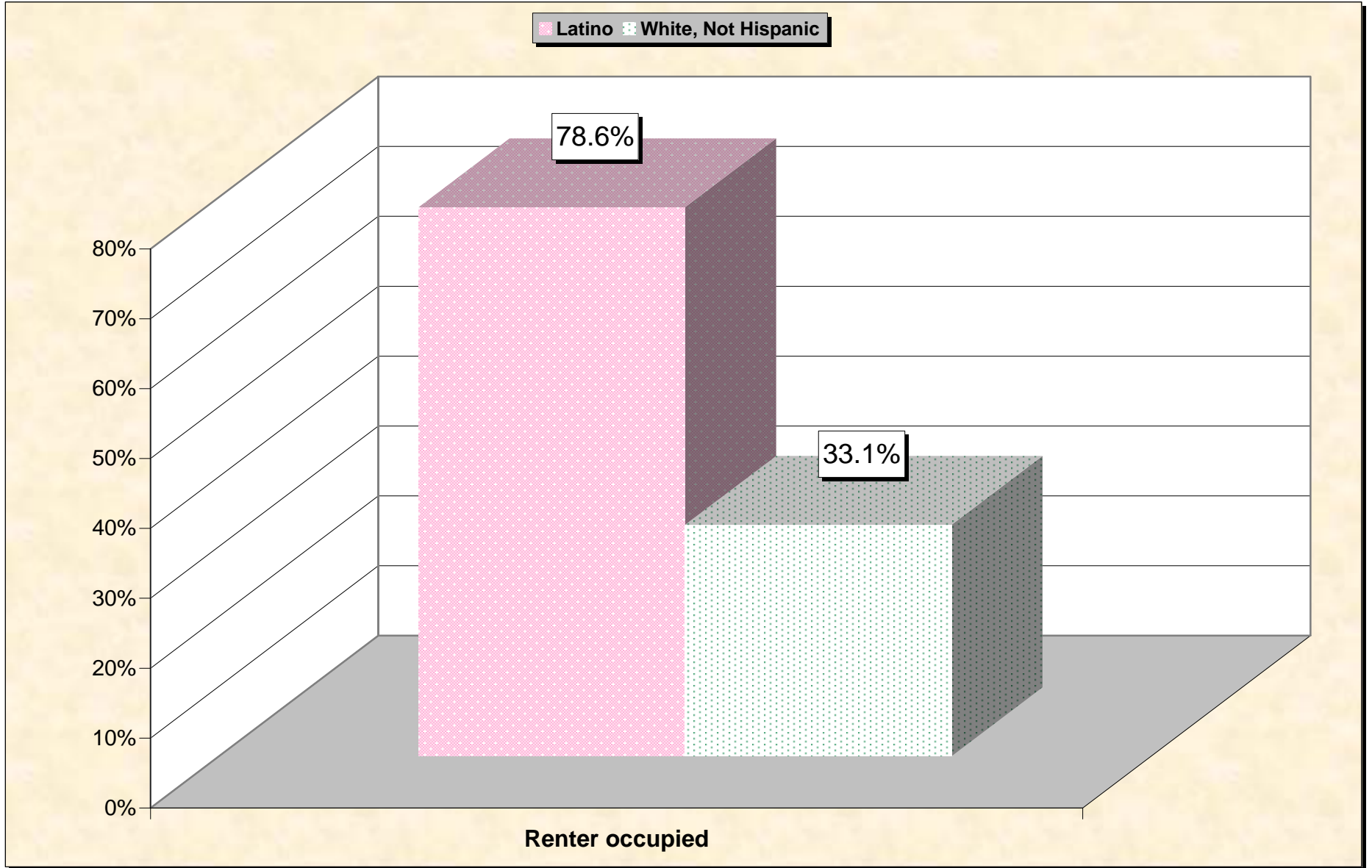

Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Massachusetts



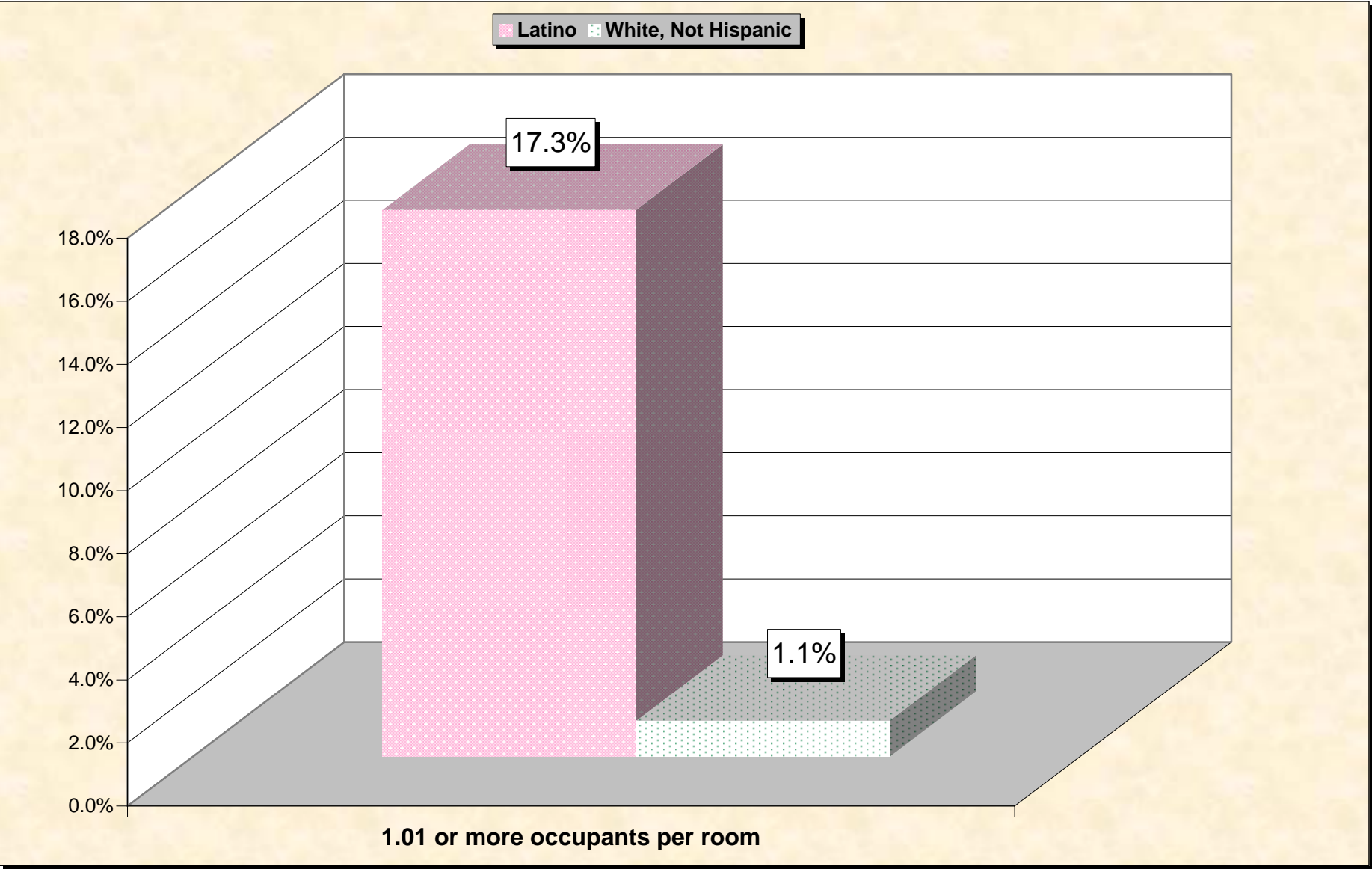

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Massachusetts



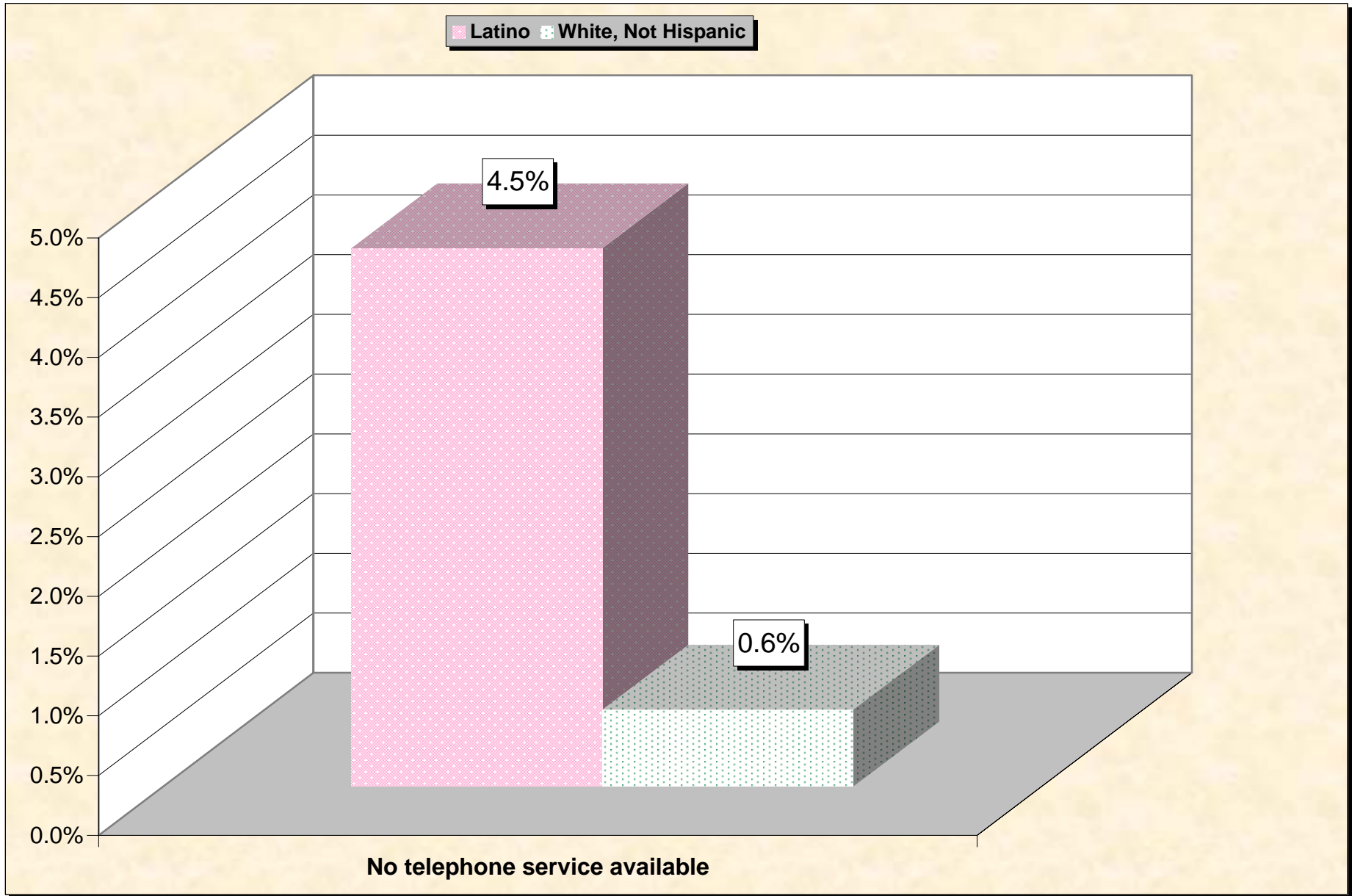

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Massachusetts



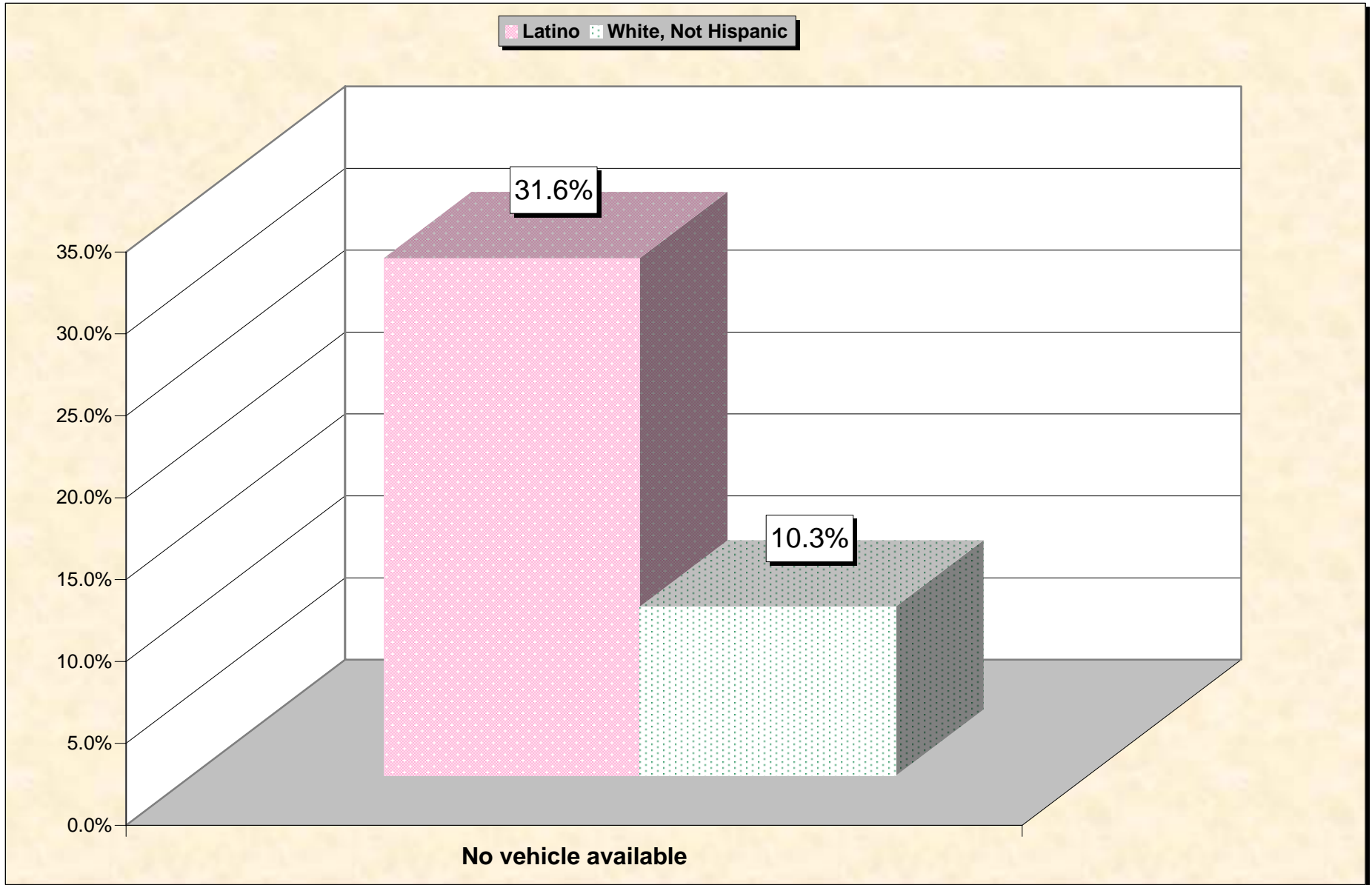

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Massachusetts



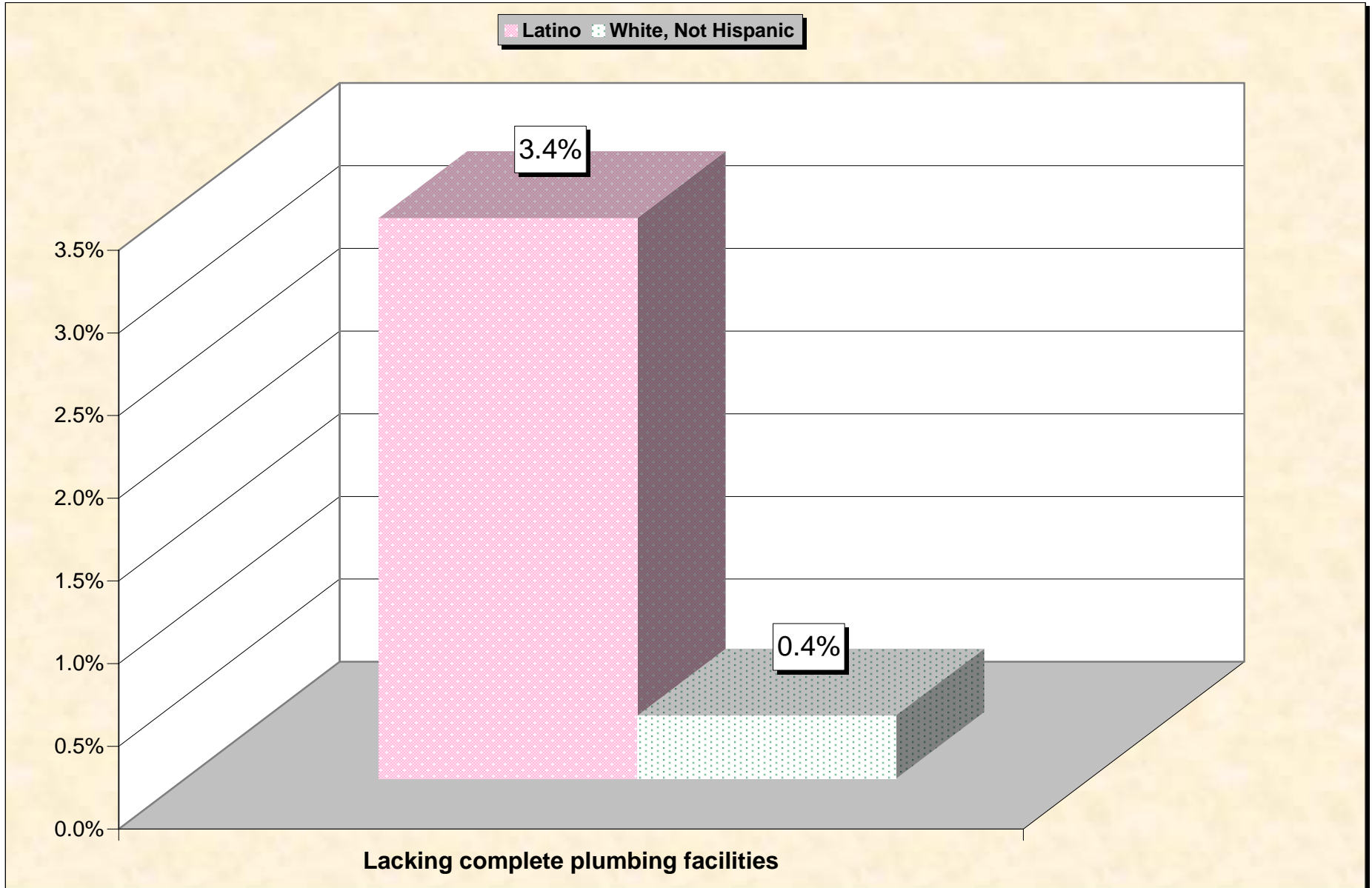

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Massachusetts



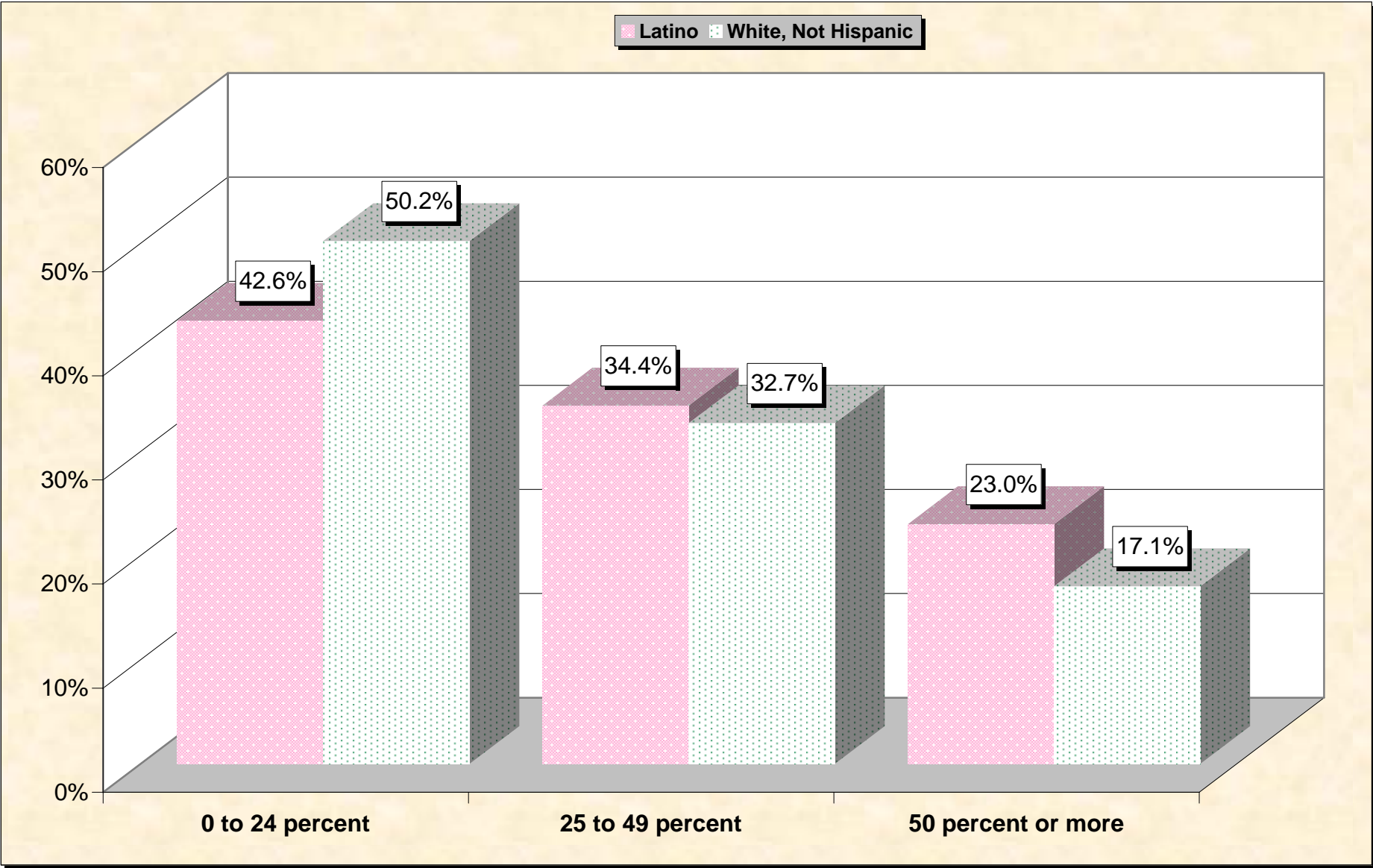

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Massachusetts



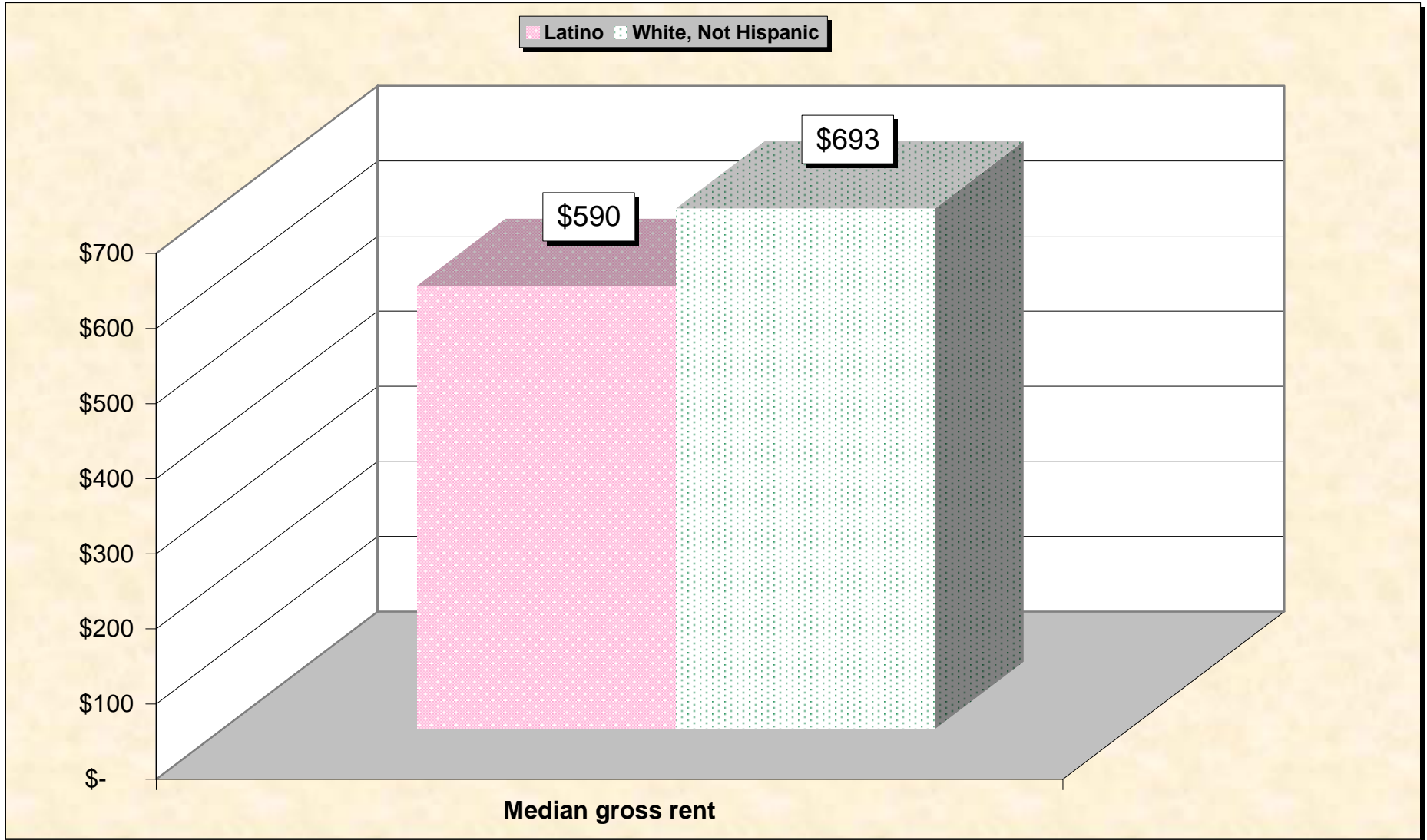

Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Massachusetts



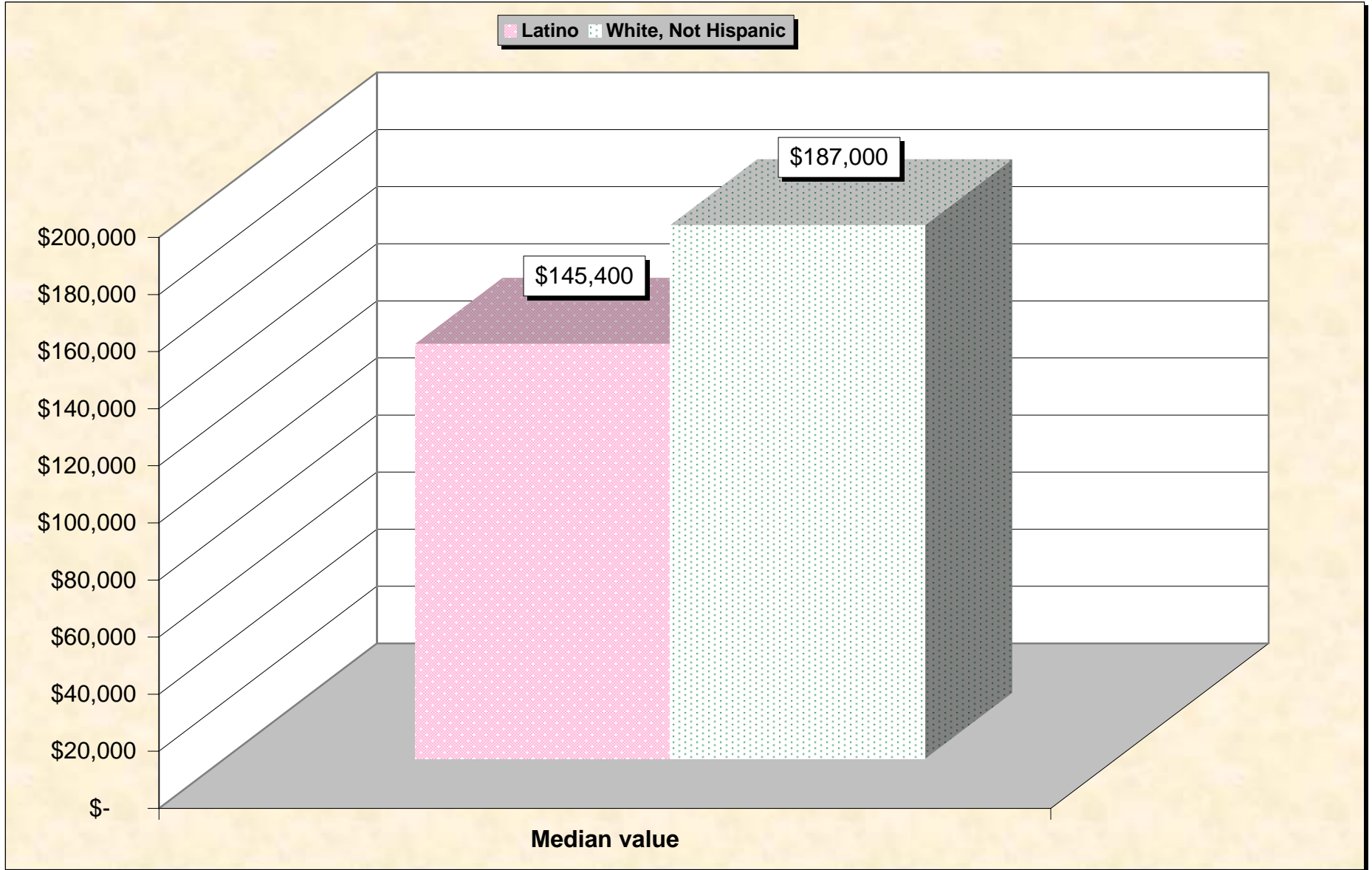
